#### **DIRECTIONS**

## **From The West**

Any convenient eastbound highway system to the Borough of Allentown. There are several choices:

Option #1: Via Interstate 195 – Take Exit 7 (Robbinsville/Allentown) and at the end of the exit ramp stay to the right so as to travel eastbound on Route 526 (also known as Robbinsville-Allentown Road). Proceed approximately 1.1 miles into the Borough of Allentown where the road is known and designated a Church Street and intersects with S. Main Street (Route 539). From this point, follow the directions set forth below entitled "From The Intersection of S. Main Street (Route 539) and Church Street."

Option: # 2: Via Interstate 195 – Take Exit 8 (Hightstown/Allentown) and at the end of the exit ramp stay to the right so as to travel southbound on Route 539 (also known as Old York Road). Proceed approximately 0.75 miles into the Borough of Allentown where the road is known and designated as Main Street. You will find 12 N. Main Street on the right hand side of the road, located immediately prior and next to the Borough of Allentown Municipal Building. If you pass these buildings, you will be approaching on your right the town bakery as well as the point where N. Main Street turns into S. Main Street and intersects with Church Street (Route 526).

Option #3: Via the Intersection of Route 130 and Route 526 (Robbinsville-Allentown Road) - Travel eastbound on Route 526 for approximately 3.26 miles into the Borough of Allentown where the road is known and designated as Main Street and intersects with Church Street (Route 526). From this point, follow the directions set forth below entitled "From The Intersection of S. Main Street (Route 539) and Church Street."

## From The East

Any convenient westbound highway system to the Borough of Allentown. There are several choices:

Option #1: Via Interstate 195 – Take Exit 8 (Hightstown/Allentown) and at the end of the exit ramp make a left hand turn on to Route 539 (also known as Old York Road) and proceed southbound approximately 0.90 miles into the Borough of Allentown where the road is known and designated as Main Street. You will find 12 N. Main Street on the right hand side of the road, located immediately prior and next to the Borough of Allentown Municipal Building. If you pass these buildings, you will be approaching on your right the town bakery as well as the point where N. Main Street turns into S. Main Street and intersects with Church Street (Route 526).

Option #2: Via Route 526 – Continue on this road until the point where it intersects with Main Street in the Borough of Allentown. Make a right hand turn onto N. Main Street. You will find 12 N. Main

Street on the left hand side of the road, located immediately after and next to the Borough of Allentown Municipal Building.

Option #3: Via Route 539- Continue on this road until the point where it intersects with Main Street in the Borough of Allentown. Make a right hand turn onto S. Main Street and proceed approximately .40 miles to 12 N. Main Street. [Shortly after you will proceed past the point where Church Street (Route 526) intersects with S. Main Street, you find 12 N. Main Street on the left hand side of the road, located immediately after and next to the Borough of Allentown Municipal Building].

## From the North

There are several choices:

Option #1-Via the NJ Turnpike – Proceed to Exit 7A (Trenton/Shore Points) and follow the exit to the eastbound lanes of Interstate 195 (towards the Shore Points). From this point, follow the directions set forth above, for travel "From the West" under Option #1 of that heading.

Option #2- Via Route #130 – At its intersection with Route 526 (Robbinsville-Allentown Road), make a left hand turn onto Route 526, From this point, follow the directions set forth above, for travel "From the West" under Option #3 of that heading.

Option #3 – Via Hightstown and Route 539 (Old York Road) – Travel southbound on Route 539 for approximately 7.5 miles into the Borough of Allentown to the point where the road is known and designated as Main Street. You will find 12 N. Main Street on the right hand side of the road, located immediately prior and next to the Borough of Allentown Municipal Building. If you pass these buildings, you will be approaching on your right the town bakery as well as the point where N. Main Street turns into S. Main Street and intersects with Church Street (Route 526).

## From the South

There are several choices:

Option #1-Via the NJ Turnpike – Proceed to Exit 7A (Trenton/Shore Points) and follow the exit to the eastbound lanes of Interstate 195 (towards the Shore Points). From this point, follow the directions set forth above, for travel "From the West" under Option #1 of that heading.

Option #2- Via Route 130 – Proceed to the point where Route 130 intersects with Interstate 195. From that point, follow the directions set forth above, for travel "From the West" under Option #1 of that heading.

Option #3 – Via Interstate 295- Proceed to the point where Interstate 295 intersects with Interstate 195. From that point, follow the directions set forth above, for travel "From the West" under Option #1 of that heading.

## From The Intersection of S. Main Street (Route 539) and Church Street:

If you are travelling east bound on Church Street (Route 526), you will come to a point where it intersects with S. Main Street (Route 539) in the Borough of Allentown. (You will see DiMattia's Restaurant directly in front of you, with the town bakery to your left and the Allentown Pharmacy to your right). At the intersection, make a left hand turn at which point you will then be travelling on N. Main Street. Shortly afterwards, you find 12 N. Main Street on the left hand side of the road. It is located immediately after and next to the Borough of Allentown Municipal Building.

**Parking:** Off Street Parking for clients and guests is available in a private parking area located behind the building and is accessible via a long private driveway which is directly adjacent to the building.

<u>Please Note</u>: The law office is located on the second floor of the building at 12 N. Main Street, in its front portion. Please enter the building via the front entrance which serves not only this law office but also a separate office in the building. The entrance leads to a reception desk and waiting room area. Please be seated in this area and wait for assistance. If necessary, please ring the bill at the reception desk for service.
